Major Programs during the Year

Aastha

Through Aastha, we have continued to provide shelter, food, and opportunities to those in need. However, from this year onwards, we decided to admit only women to our residential facility.

By the end of the financial year, around 40 women had benefitted from this program. During the year, Aastha provided shelter to 6 women in distress. As of March 31st, 2024, 2 elderly women were residing at Aastha.

Although the numbers may seem small, we are proud that our program has brought meaningful, positive change to the lives of our residents, helping them overcome some of their toughest challenges. One such story is that of Priyanka.

Aastha Bhojanalaya has been a valuable contributor to the Aastha program. It has provided delicious meals to the residents and offered them employment opportunities, allowing them to earn wages, rebuild their confidence, and regain their dignity. Despite not yet being financially self-sufficient, and besides preparing the rice packets served free of cost under the Don Ghas program, Aastha Bhojanalaya generated revenue of ₹10,56,912 this financial year by serving affordable and tasty food to hundreds of satisfied customers.

Don Ghas is dedicated to offering free meals to patients, their families, and caregivers at government hospitals in Amravati.

This initiative was launched in 2023 in collaboration with the NGO With Arya and is supported by generous individuals.

Under this program, we distribute meals every evening at Irwin Hospital (District General Hospital), Amravati. By the end of this financial year, we have provided around 23,000 meals, with approximately 20,000 of these meals distributed during this financial year.

Expenditures and Funds Raised

Our total expenses for the year amounted to ₹20,51,032, including program costs of approximately ₹19,22,014. Despite raising ₹19,91,381 through donations, grants, and revenue from Aastha Bhojanalaya, our liabilities increased by approximately ₹59,651 during the year. These liabilities were covered through payables and interest-free unsecured loans.

Plan for Next Year

As before, our goal is to achieve sustainability for Aastha through grants, donations, and revenue from Aastha Bhojanalaya. Although we did not achieve this in the current financial year, we remain hopeful for the upcoming year and are committed to continuing our efforts to stabilize and sustain Aastha.
